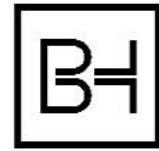

## General Rules & Etiquette

Please read ALL sections **carefully!**

- Entry Fee: 25 cents per entry. All ages allowed two entries per class number, except where specified. Individual entries must be made in person. An entry cannot be placed in two classes; one class must be chosen.**
- Entry Drop-off:**
  - Thursday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, 6:00pm-9:00pm  
**All Arts, Photography, Crafts and Hobbies entries must be brought in at this time (Horticulture and Cooking also accepted).**
  - Friday, September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2:30pm-6:00pm  
**Only Horticulture and Cooking entries will be accepted on Friday. No Arts, Photography, Crafts and Hobbies will be accepted this day. Doors will be closed at 6:00pm sharp.**
  - Judging will begin at 7:00pm. The Show will be open for viewing at 9:00am on Saturday, September 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Location:** All entries must be delivered to the Springbank Park For All Seasons Curling Rink.
- Registration Number:** All entrants will receive a registration number to be used on all entry tags along with the entrant's name. Please pick up your tags and registration number ahead of time from the SPFAS Administration Office.
- Entry Tags:** Available to be picked up from the SPFAS Administration Office starting August 10<sup>th</sup>, Monday to Friday from 9am to 3pm. We request that exhibitors entering more than 5 entries obtain their entry tags prior to September 10<sup>th</sup> and have them completed prior to delivering entries. Children's entry tags must be labeled with the correct age category. All entry tags will be paid for at pick up, any unused tags will be reimbursed if returned.
- Ownership:** All entries must be the work of the exhibitor, and must not have been shown in previous Springbank Park For All Seasons Agricultural Society Fall Fairs.
- Judging:** Containers do not count in judging unless one is specified. **Note carefully the number of articles required for each class number and any other particulars given for each class, errors may disqualify the entry.** Classes may be set up at the discretion of the judges or a class may be subdivided if there are numerous entries. The Danish system of judging is used in this competition. In this system, coloured ribbons are used to indicate the placing in the competition. Each entry is judged against a standard and is given a rating. Each entry that receives a placement ribbon will also be awarded points. Only first, second, and third placement will be awarded per class, all judge's decisions are final.  
  
Ribbons are awarded in each class number. **Red ribbon (1<sup>st</sup> place)=3 points, Blue ribbon (2<sup>nd</sup> place)=2 points, White ribbon (3<sup>rd</sup> place)=1 point.** Cash prizes will be awarded to entrants that place 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in total points for each subcategory. Trophies are awarded on the basis of a total point system for each category.  
  
It is the prize winner's responsibility to pick up their awarded prize the day of the Fall Fair (unless other arrangements have previously been made). Any unclaimed prizes will be used in the following Fall Fair.
- Disclaimer:** Neither the Fall Fair Organizing Committee nor the Springbank Park For All Seasons Agricultural Society is responsible for any loss or damages to property while it is on exhibit. The committee shall take reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of all articles.
- Removal of Entries:** Entries may not be removed from the display **until after the awards presentation on Saturday afternoon.** Any articles remaining unclaimed after 4:30pm on the day of the show will become the property of the show committee.
- SPFAS would be pleased to recycle ribbons, please bring any previous year's ribbons to registration.

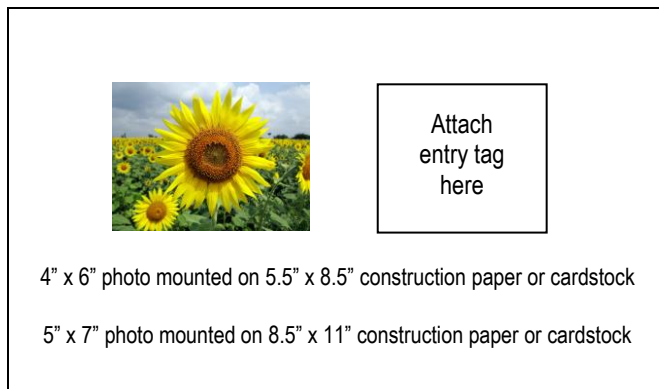

- has a thin crust and moist interior
- has a fine, even interior texture
- is light
- has a pleasant taste and aroma

### The "Ideal" Cake and Cupcake

- has a flat or slightly rounded top
- has a moist, fine grained, slightly glossy surface
- has a fine, velvety texture
- has small cells throughout the cupcake
- does not crumble significantly when cut
- is tender
- has characteristic, pleasant flavor

### The "Ideal" Pie Crust

- has tiny blisters
- is very delicately browned
- is tender and flaky
- has a pleasant, bland flavor which does not interfere with the flavor of the filling

Recipe taken from the 1954 Springbank UCW  
Cookbook

Submitted By Terry Ona

2 eggs	1 cup flour
1 cup sugar	1 tsp. baking powder
½ cup milk	1 tsp. vanilla
1 tbsp. butter	Pinch of salt

Heat milk and butter, beat eggs, add sugar, beating well. Stir in dry ingredients. Add vanilla and carefully stir in hot milk and butter. Batter is very thin.

Bake in shallow pan (9" square pan) for 25 mins at 350 degrees F. After baking, cover the top with the following:

Combine 2/3 cup brown sugar, 1/3 cup melted butter, 1 cup coconut, 4 tbsp. cream. Spread on top of baked cake and put under broiler until brown and bubbly. (Leave cake in pan to exhibit)

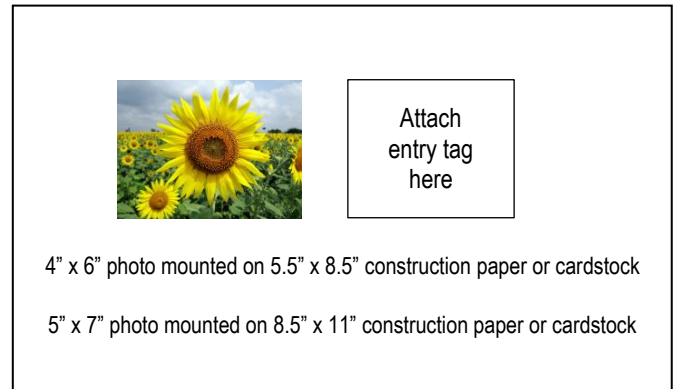

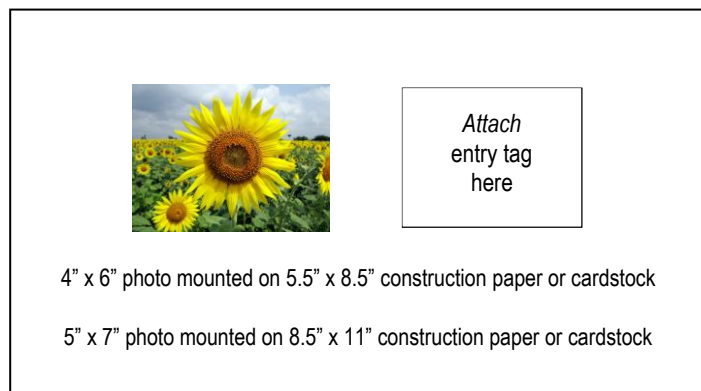

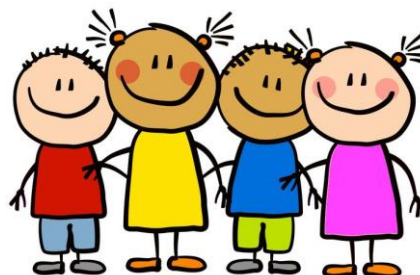

- 1½ cups flour
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 1 tsp. baking powder
- ½ tsp. salt
- 4 tbsp. cocoa

Make 3 holes in dry ingredients.

- 1<sup>st</sup> hole put 1 tbsp. vinegar
- 2<sup>nd</sup> hole put 1 tsp. vanilla
- 3<sup>rd</sup> hole put 5 tbsp. melted butter

Then pour 1 cup of warm water over all. Mix well together until flour disappears. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees F) for about 30 mins. Exhibit whole cake un-iced in pan.
